- To meet carbon targets the government is likely to:
 - Tighten the code for sustainable homes
 - Require homes to be retrofitted
 - Introduce LCA labelling
 - Take into account embodied carbon
- Innovative plant-based materials reduce the embodied and operational carbon of buildings
